The Chris Upton Memorial Trophy 2010 will take the form of a Christian Arts competition. This competition is open to all Members of the Company / Senior Sections / Amicus Groups of Boys' Brigade / Boys' Brigade & Girls' Association Companies in the Birmingham Battalion.

Companies are invited to make a presentation in one of the following media, based upon the chosen theme.

Speech or drama, music, mime, DVD or puppetry.

This could prove an exciting and challenging event for the young people in your Company and the emphasis is very much on input from them. The adjudicators will wish to speak to those taking part about their input into the preparation of their presentation and to receive a brief synopsis of how they devised the presentation prior to the event.

The following theme has been chosen for the Competition :

TEMPTATION

You might like to base your presentation on a story from the Bible, for example : The Story of Adam & Eve (Genesis Chapter 3) or The Temptation of Jesus (Matthew Chapter 4 verses 1-11). Alternatively you can choose your own Bible verses.

Presentations are judged in 5 categories and marked out of the following:

Preparation Input by Young People	20 marks
Dramatic / Artistic Effect	20 marks
Presentation (including props etc)	20 marks
Interpretation of Theme	20 marks
Overall Impression	20 marks.

Presentations should be no longer than 10 minutes and ½ a mark is deducted for each 15 seconds over that time.

All entries will be judged on **Monday 8 March 2010** and at Carrs Lane Church Centre, Dale End, Birmingham. If your Company wishes to enter this challenging event, please complete the form enclosed. The Rules for the Competition are listed on the reverse of this sheet. **The closing date for entries is Friday 12 February 2010.**

Please encourage your members to take part in this Bible-based competition, which we hope will be both challenging and enjoyable and is very different from most of our sporting competitions.
